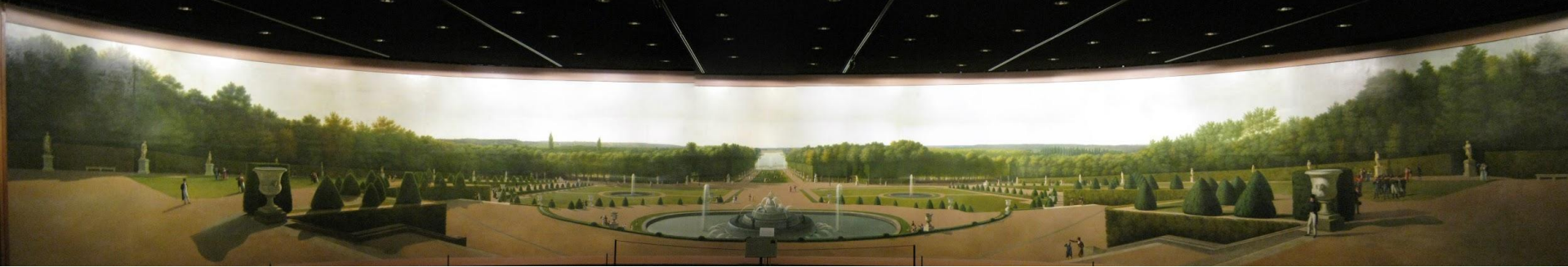
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WHAT IS VIRTUAL REALITY?

- It began in the nineteenth century.
- Panoramic paintings were the earliest attempt at virtual reality.
- 1838-Charles Wheatstone invented the View-Master stereoscope.
- 1929-Edward Link created the “Link trainer” an example of commercial flight simulator.
- 1950s- Morton Heilig developed the Sensorama
